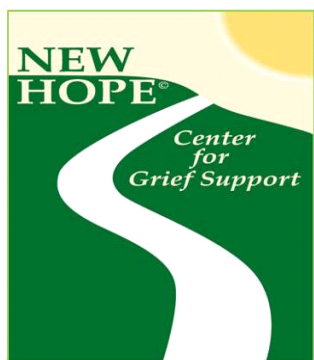

From Grief to New Hope workshops are educational and interactive and for the past ten years have proven to be effective at helping grieving people heal after the devastation of losing a loved one. They begin with the understanding that everyone's path through grief is unique, but that the journey is best traveled with knowledgeable and compassionate people who can help grieving individuals fully experience their loss and come to a place of hope and healing. Specifically, each week a different grief related topic is presented during a 30-40 minute talk. After that, breakout groups are formed that allow everyone the opportunity, if they choose, to share their own grief story. 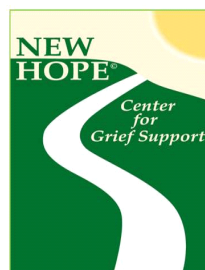
